

**Bay View Bicycle Club**  
Ride Schedule for May 11, 2019 - June 30, 2019  
All Rides Start at 9:00AM (May through September)

**Tuesdays**- Morning Rides (May - October) - miles vary

Start at 9:00am from Buelah Brinton Community Center, 2555 S Bay St, Bay View. Routes determined day of ride but are usually around 20 miles.

**May 11, 2019**- Germantown Roll - 24, 32, 40 miles

Ride from Germantown through rural Washington County to West Bend. - Starts at Haupt Strasse Park in Germantown. Take Hwy 45 north to Mequon Rd (167east). Go east to Western Ave. (stoplight, Medical Associates on corner). Left (north) on Western Ave. 1/2 miles to park A Porta Potty is available in park. Approximate drive time from zoo: 30 minutes

**May 12, 2019**- White River Trail - 21, 37 miles

Scenic ride west of Burlington through Lyons and Springfield via the White River State Trail. Alternate 37 mile return avoids unpaved trail and trail pass requirement. - Starts at Echo Park in Burlington. Take US 45 south to Loomis Rd, turn right on Loomis Rd/WI 36 south for 17.6 miles. Stay to the right to exit on Milwaukee Ave. Continue 3.5 miles on Milwaukee Ave to Echo Prk. Restrooms are available in the park. State Trail pass is required for the original 37 mile route (alternate return avoids this requirement). Approximate drive time from zoo: 35 minutes

**May 15, 2019**- Ride of Silence - 10 miles

Easy ride in silence at a very slow pace. Ride to honor bicyclists killed by motorists, promote sharing the road, and promote awareness of bicycling safety. - Starts at 7:00 pm at all Wheel & Sprocket locations. BVBC will have a Ride Coordinator at the Hales Corners location. If you ride from a different store, please inform the Ride Chair to be credited with Rider Points.

**May 18, 2019**- Classic Mash Up - 29, 40 miles

Ride from Oconomowoc to Ixonia and Dousman on former BVBC Classic route. - Starts at Roosevelt Park in Oconomowoc. Take I-94 west to WI 67. Take WI 67 north (becomes Summit) for 2.5 miles. Turn left on Forest St. half-mile into park. Restrooms are available in park. Approximate drive time: 30 minutes from Zoo

**May 19, 2019**- Mukwonago - 26, 34, 45, 54 miles

Rural ride east and south of Mukwonago with the long route going to Burlington. - Starts at Mukwonago High School - 605 W. School Rd, Mukwonago. From Milwaukee take I-43 south to exit #43 (WI 83). Turn right (north) on WI 83/Rochester St. Follow WI 83 for 1.7 miles to CR NN. Turn left on NN and follow 1/2 mile to school. Porta potties are typically available in the area. Approximate drive time from zoo: 25 minutes.

**May 25, 2019-** Whitnall South - 22, 37, 58 miles

Easy ride into Racine county and back - Starts at Whitnall Park Golf Course on 92nd Street just north of Rawson Ave. Restrooms are available in golf clubhouse.

**May 26, 2019-** Gils Ride from Rome - 21, 33, 48 miles

Scenic ride through Jefferson County to Helenville and back. - Starts at the Rome Pond Park, east of Rome on County Hwy F. Take I-94 west to exit #275, CR F for Sullivan/Ixonia (this is the second CR F traveling west from Milwaukee - do not exit at the one in Pewaukee with Steinhafels and the former American TV). Take CR F south 4.6 miles to Sullivan. Turn Right on CR F/Hwy 18 (Main St). Continue on CR F approximately 3.1 miles to park on left. A pit toilet is available at park. Approximate drive time from zoo: 40 minutes.

**May 27, 2019-** Oak Leaf - Tosa to Dretzka - 26 miles

Easy out and back ride on the Menomonee River Parkway and Oak Leaf Trail. - Starts at Hart Park in Wauwatosa. Take I-94 to 68th Street. Head north on 68th 1.1 miles to State Street. Turn left on State Street and go four blocks to 72nd. Turn left on 72nd and drive all the way past the football field and park at the far south end of the lot. Restrooms are available in park.

**Jun 1, 2019-** Kenosha Southport Harbor - 34 miles

Scenic trail ride along Lake Michigan to Carol Beach and Illinois border and Lake Andrea. **NEW FOR 2019:** Route is a single distance with return on city streets. - Starts in Petrifying Springs Park in Kenosha. Take I-94 south, exit at County E (Kenosha), east on County E approximately 5 miles to Hwy 31, left on Hwy 31 for 0.3 miles, right on County JR for 0.5 miles turn left into park and use the first lot on the left (adjacent to the dog park and beer garden). Restrooms are available in park. Approximate drive time from zoo: 45 minutes. **After the ride: Join us as we continue our new tradition – ‘Scrumptious Saturdays’!** On the first Saturday of every month, we’ll be gathering after the ride at some of our favorite places for food and beverages. Today, it’ll be the sandwiches, beverages, and Gemütlichkeit of the Petrifying Springs Beer Garden. Ein Prosit!

**Jun 2, 2019-** Three Trails West - 15, 24, 26, 39 miles

Glacial Drumlin, Cushing Park, Lake Country trails to Lapham Peak, Delafield, or Oconomowoc. - Starts at Fox River Sanctuary in Waukesha. Take I-94 West to Waukesha Cty F and turn left. Take Cty F/Redford Blvd/North St southwest for 3.4 miles. Turn right onto St. Paul Ave and continue 0.3 miles. Turn left onto Prairie Ave. 0.3 miles to College Ave. Parking lot is on right. Restrooms are available in park. Approximate drive time from zoo: 20 minutes

**Jun 8, 2019-** Past Presidents Picnic - 30 miles **←←← Note new date!**

Starts Virmond Park. Ride open to all/Picnic for members only. Easy ride along Lake Michigan to Port Washington and back. - Starts at Virmond Park in Mequon. Take I-43 to Mequon Rd. East on Mequon Rd. to Lakeshore Dr. South approximately 3/4 mile to Virmond Park (on left). Approximate drive time: 25 minutes from Zoo. **After the ride: Join us for our annual Past Presidents Picnic.** The club will be providing grilled sandwiches and veggie kabobs. To participate,

bring dish to pass (preferred!) or \$10 (booo!). If your dish needs to be kept chilled during the ride, please bring it in a suitable cooler.

**Jun 9, 2019**- Burlington Roll - 23, 33, 50 miles

Easy ride from Wind Lake through Waterford and rural Racine County. - Starts at Heg Park in Norway, WI. Take WI 36 (Loomis Rd) south towards Wind Lake. Heg Park is approximately 1 mile past Wind Lake, watch for signs on the right. Restrooms are available in park. Approximate drive time from zoo: 25 minutes.

**Jun 15, 2019**- Menomonee Falls/Neosho - 29, 50, 60 miles **←←← Note new date!**

Ride west from Menomonee Falls to Neosho and back. Scenic and very challenging in spots. - Starts at Village Park in Menomonee Falls. North on I-41/US-45 to Appleton Ave. Northwest on Appleton Ave to Garfield Dr. (across from bank in downtown). Left on Garfield Dr. to Village Park on left. Restrooms are available in park. Approximate drive time from zoo: 20 minutes.

**Jun 16, 2019**- Glacial River Trail - 34, 41, 53 miles

Ride along the Jefferson County trail and return along the Rock River. Long route encircles Lake Koshkonong. - Starts at Jefferson High School - 700 W Milwaukee St; Jefferson, WI 53549. Take I-94 West to Wi Highway 26 (Exit 267 - Johnson Creek). South on WI-26 for eight miles to US Hwy-18 (Racine Street). East on Hwy-18 for 0.7 miles. Turn right on Taft Street and go one block to school. A Porta Potty is typically available adjacent to the tennis courts. Approximate drive time from zoo: 40 minutes.

**Jun 22, 2019**- Cedarburg - 25, 34, 49 miles

Very scenic ride through rural area north of Cedarburg. - Starts at Centennial Park. Take I-43 north to County C (exit 89), west on C to Wauwatosa Rd (181), right on Wauwatosa Rd to Bridge St. Right on Bridge St. to Evergreen Blvd, left on Evergreen Blvd approximately three blocks. Street parking or Pool/Waterpark lot. Restrooms are available in pool building. Approximate drive time from zoo: 35 minutes. **After the ride:** Join fellow club members as we stroll the streets of downtown **Cedarburg for the annual Strawberry Fest!**

**Jun 23, 2019**- South Hills - 23, 40, 49 miles

Mostly flat ride through Racine County farmlands. **Route slightly reworked for 2019** but still starts at South Hills Golf Course in Racine County, 3047 S 27th St, Franksville. Take I-94 south to County K, exit on K, take east frontage road 1.5 miles south to golf course. Restrooms are available in clubhouse. Approximate drive time from zoo: 25 minutes.

**Jun 29, 2019**- Lake Mills Triangle - 29, 41, 56 miles

Very scenic ride from Lake Mills to Cambridge and west to Lake Kegonsa State Park. Longer routes hilly. - Starts at Rotary Park in Lake Mills. Take I-94 West to Exit 259 (Lake Mills). Proceed south on Hwy 89 approximately 2 miles and turn right on Sandy Beach Road. Park in Rotary Park lot on right. Restrooms are available in the park. Approximate drive time from zoo: 50 minutes. **After the ride: Save time to check out Lake Mills Town and Country Days.** Looking for a more relaxing time? Check out **Sandy Beach on Lake Mills** just down the street (admission fee required).

**Jun 30, 2019**- Tosa - Falls - 26, 40 miles

Ride following stretches of the Menomonee River Parkway, Oak Leaf Trail, and suburban streets. The long route takes the Bugline Trail to Sussex. - Starts at Hart Park in Wauwatosa. Take I-94 to 68th Street. Head north on 68th 1.1 miles to State Street. Turn left on State Street and go four blocks to 72nd. Turn left on 72nd and drive all the way past the football field and park at the far south end of the lot. Restrooms are available in the park.
